Dear SKSS PAC,

The SKSS Music Department would like to request financial assistance from the PAC which would support our music department.

The music department has grown to include five bands, one of which includes our school's jazz band. This year, our SKSS Jazz Band consists of twenty one very dedicated students ranging from grades 8-12. Our students rehearse at 7am on Tuesday and Thursday mornings.

This year, our jazz band will be participating in the BC Interior Jazz Festival in Kelowna from April 7-9. The festival is in its 42nd year running, and it is extremely well known for its high-calibre workshop clinicians and professional concerts put on for the participating groups. Our students will be participating in the jazz band class as well as the jazz combo class, as a group of dedicated jazz students have started an extra-curricular jazz combo group as well.

Performing in such a festival would not only be extremely beneficial for our young musicians, but I am almost certain that it would bring a great deal of positive recognition for our school. These young musicians are exceptional, and if they place, they will be invited to play in the showcase event that weekend. From there, our jazz band could be invited to Musicfest Canada for nationals.

As our major fundraising efforts have been thwarted several times because of Covid restrictions, I would like to ask PAC for financial assistance in order to help our group attend this festival. Our expenses include renting a school bus for three days (approx. \$1000), hotel accommodation for two nights for 21 students and chaperones (approx. \$5000), TTOC coverage for my classes for two days (\$945.83), and festival fees for the jazz band and the jazz combo students (\$810). Any assistance that PAC could offer would be so greatly appreciated.

Please consider the SKSS Music Department's request for financial assistance to attend the BC Interior Jazz Festival in Kelowna from April 7-9.
