Care of Grad Gowns, Caps & Tassels, and V Stoles

This is the gown, cap & tassel, and V stole (commencement regalia) that you will wear for photos **AND** for the commencement ceremony this spring.

You must find a place to safely store all of your regalia until commencements.

If you lose or damage an item of your commencement regalia, you will need to pay to replace the item - this will include the item cost, shipping, taxes, and any other late service charges. Replacement items require 8 weeks to arrive. This means that if you need to replace an item, you would need to let the office know by the end of March.

Care instructions from Gaspard - gown company

V Stoles

- V stoles are worn with the V in the front.
- Do **NOT** iron V Stoles - if absolutely necessary maybe a bit of steaming.
- Hang them on the gown and hanger and fold crease should soften up.

Gowns

- Gowns can be ironed on medium heat or steamed.
- Some schools have even suggested for those that do not have either an iron or a steamer to spritz water on gown and throw it in dryer or hang in washroom during a shower to help soften out the wrinkles.
- They can be stored in the closet on a hanger until ceremony.

Caps and Tassels

- Do **NOT** lose your tassel!
- Store cap and tassel together in a safe place where it will not get bent
